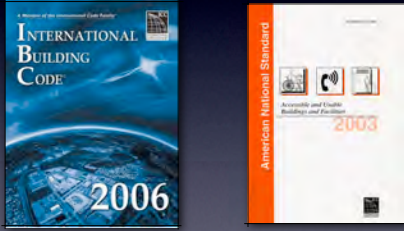

**2004 ADAAG** -- requirements set forth in appendices B and D to 36 CFR part 1191 (2009)

**2010 Standards** -- 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design, which consist of the 2004 ADAAG and the requirements contained in § 35.151

## Noteworthy Changes...

There Are Also Decreased Requirements...

- Accessible route from site arrival points and within sites
- Use of a "LULA" when elevator is not required
- Covered passenger loading zone at medical care and long-term care facilities
- Accessible seating in larger assembly areas
- Accessible route to small press boxes...
